2010 Showfield Entry Procedures and Classes: FAQs

We appreciate you coming to Carlisle! We're glad to have you. To make this year's visit better than ever, we've compiled answers to commonly-asked questions for your reference and convenience. Registration Procedures

Q: How do I pre-register?

A: You may either pre-register by phone (717-243-7855) or through the **website:** <http://store.carlisleevents.com>

Q: What are the pre-registration and registration deadlines?

Q: What is Gate-N-Go?

A: **Gate-N-Go** is a new and convenient pre-registration process that saves you time and money – not to mention the ability to drive directly through our gate without stopping to get credentials. By pre-registering, you will receive stickers via USPS in advance of the event and save \$10.00 in the process. This also means you don't have to stand in line when you arrive at the show; rather you can drive straight in!

Q: What do I need to know about registering for camping or trailer parking?

A: There is limited availability. If you are planning to camp or tow a trailer, don't hesitate, register for showfield and reserve your spaces today before it is too late! Pre-registration for camping and trailer parking is offered only to pre-registered showfield participants. Camping and trailer parking stickers will be mailed in advance of the event to participants who have pre-registered; all other pre-registrants will pick them up at the show.

Q: What is the registration process prior to 30-days pre-event (considered 'pre-registration')?

A: Below are the steps specific to registration anytime before 30 days out from the show:

1. Register by phone (717.243.7855), website (www.CarlisleEvents.com) or mail (1000 Bryn Mawr Road; Carlisle, PA 17013).
2. Select class when registering (as applicable to event). Note: Performance & Style, Truck Nationals and Corvettes at Carlisle do not have classification.
3. Register for camping and/or trailer parking if needed.
4. Carlisle Events will mail your stickers to you approximately one month before the show.
5. Bring the stickers with you to Carlisle. Note: If you are trailering your show vehicle, be sure to affix the appropriate stickers to your tow vehicle and trailer as well as the showfield sticker to the windshield of your show vehicle. Camping stickers must also be applied to vehicle windshields before entering the camping area.
6. Upon arrival, you may enter at Gate 3 and proceed to the designated parking area. You will be directed by Carlisle Events staff.

Q: What is the registration process after the 30-days pre-event / 'pre-registration' cutoff, and before the 19 days-before-event deadline?

A: Below are the steps specific to registration anytime between the 30th and 19th day cutoffs:

1. Register by phone (717.243.7855), website (www.CarlisleEvents.com) or mail (1000 Bryn Mawr Road; Carlisle, PA 17013).
2. Select class when registering (as applicable to event). Note: Performance & Style, Truck Nationals and Corvettes at Carlisle do not have classification.
3. Stickers will *not* be mailed.
4. Participants will need to proceed to Showfield Registration outside Gate 3.
5. After leaving Showfield Registration, guests may then proceed to the designated parking area, guided by Carlisle Events staff.

Q: What is the registration process after the 19 days-pre-event deadline?

A: Below are the steps specific to registration anytime between the 19th day cutoff and the day of the show:

1. Register by phone (717.243.7855), website (www.CarlisleEvents.com) or mail (1000 Bryn Mawr Road; Carlisle, PA 17013).
2. Select class when registering (as applicable to event). Note: Performance & Style, Truck Nationals and Corvettes at Carlisle do not have classification.
3. Stickers will *not* be mailed.
4. Participants will need to proceed to Showfield Registration outside Gate 3.

5. After leaving Showfield Registration, guests may then proceed to the designated parking area, guided by Carlisle Events staff.
6. Important Note: Within 19 days of the event, the process and costs are the same as 'Day of Show.'

Day of Show Entry

Q: Which gate should I enter?

A: We ask that you pass through our main gate – **Gate #3**. You may enter **1000 Bryn Mawr Road, Carlisle PA 17013** into your GPS or an online mapping program to find it easily.

Q: What do I do with my window sticker?

A: Before you arrive at the gate, please place the window sticker on the driver's side upper corner of your windshield?

Q: Does the window sticker have to go on my showfield car? What about my trailer or my tow vehicle?

A: Yes, please affix the showfield sticker to the windshield of your show vehicle. Please do not put the showfield sticker on any vehicle other than your show vehicle.

As far as your trailer and tow vehicle, per your trailering-specific registration, you will receive designated stickers for your tow vehicle and trailer. Please affix these stickers to the respective vehicles. This will allow you, for instance, to keep your trailer in your trailer parking space all weekend while being able to drive your tow vehicle on and off grounds as necessary.

Q: After entering the gate, where do I go?

A: Our staff will be there to help you navigate to the designated parking area. You'll be guided from the gate forward.

Q: Once parked, what next (e.g. Where do I pick up my Goody Bag)?

A: Welcome to Carlisle! After your trip into town, you may be tired, thirsty or hungry. Make yourself at home. Also, once parked, you are welcome to proceed on foot to the Goody Bag pickup location off Duke Boulevard (spaces IE 74-77, near the stage) where you may present your coupon/receipt for your Goody Bag and all other appropriate items (e.g. dash card). As applicable, your judging form will be available for pick up at this time as well.

Q: I'm new to Carlisle. What is the venue like and what is the overall fairground layout?

A: We're glad to have you as our guest. In fact, we imagine this will be one of many future trips to Carlisle.

Q: May I place a 'for sale' sign on my car?

A: Unfortunately, no. "For sale" signs are not permitted on the showfield. If you would like to sell your vehicle, please call 717-243-7855 to reserve a Car Corral space where the buyers that you will see will be shopping for cars. Many services are available to aid in the sales process (e.g. on-site notary and banking services).

Showfield Classification

Q: How do I check which class my vehicle will be in?

A: Please see table below:

Also, when choosing your class, use this guide to determine stock, modified, street rod, etc.

- **Stock**
 - Vehicle must appear stock inside and out. Three minor changes are permitted such as non-stock wheels, repaint in a factory color (that is correct for the model) and minor engine enhancements.
- **Modified**
 - Vehicle has more than three minor changes, been changed under the hood, has non-factory paint, has non-stock wheels, and/or interior changes.
- **Pro Street / Race Prepared**
 - Vehicle has two or more of the following: tubbed, engine out of hood/blown, roll cage, nitrous, 5-point harness.
- **Street Rod**
 - 1948 and older.
